Dear Owner or Tenant:

Public Service Electric and Gas Company (PSE&G) has successfully completed its objectives and regulatory requirements to remediate onsite soil impacts from the past operations of the former manufactured gas plant (MGP) in Harrison and replace natural gas pipelines. Restoration work also is now complete.

On behalf of its contractors and employees, the PSE&G site remediation group would like to thank the Town of Harrison; the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey; PSE&G employees; the owners, property managers and residents of Vermella, Steel Works, Cobalt Lofts apartments; La Joia restaurant, and all our neighbors for their cooperation and patience throughout the remediation and restoration of the former MGP site.

The remediation work began in July 2020 and was completed in December 2021 using methods to stabilize the soil impacts below ground on the site. Restoration of the site and the surrounding property was completed in April 2022.

The Site currently houses a natural gas Metering and Regulating Station (M&R) and is also used by other PSE&G operations.

Work was performed according to the guidance and protocols of the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection and under the direction of a Licensed Site Remediation Professional. PSE&G will develop and submit a Remedial Action Report documenting this work. Groundwater monitoring will continue.
